



Getting To and Around Mason

Shuttles

Mason has five **FREE shuttles** going to on and off-campus destinations. The shuttles provide an easy, green, and fast way to travel to Mason. For up-to-date schedules and other shuttle information, visit shuttle.gmu.edu.

Mason to Metro Shuttle runs between the Fairfax campus and Vienna Metro station from 6:00am-12:00am on M-F. Extended service is until 3:30am on Friday, 8:30pm-3:30am on Saturday night, and 5:30pm-11:30pm on Sunday to help you get back and forth to DC!

Prince William Shuttle runs between the Fairfax and Prince William campuses from 7:00am-10:20pm on M-F. The shuttle also stops at Target in Manassas Mall.

Gunston Go Bus provides service from Fairfax campus to University Mall, Fair Lakes Center, Fair Oaks Mall, Fairfax Corner, and Old Town Fairfax from 3:00pm-10:00pm 7 days a week with late hours until 1am on Friday and Saturday. Service to Fairfax Square is provided 7 days a week at 10:30pm and 11:10pm only.

West Campus Express operates from 7:00am-1:00am on M-F and 2:00pm-1:00am on Sunday, providing service every 15-20 minutes between Presidents Park and West Campus lot, with stops in between at Rappahannock River Ln and the Field House.

Campus Circulator operates from 8:00am-11:00pm on M-F, providing service around Patriot Circle every 15-20 minutes with stops at Sandy Creek, Mattaponi River Ln, Concert Hall, Aquia Creek Ln, Chesapeake River Ln, Masonvale, and Presidents Park.

CUE BUS

Biking

Ride your bike to campus! It's a fun, healthy, and an efficient way to get around. Mason was recently awarded the title of a **Bicycle Friendly University** (one of only 26 in the country and the only one in Virginia) and with over 800 bike parking spaces, you'll always have a place to park your bike close to class. Look for **bicycle pumps being installed around campus** this semester and keep an eye out for bike maintenance and safety events along with the annual **Bike to Mason Day during Earth Week**.
