GMU MOTORCYCLE SURFACE LOT PARKING REGULATIONS

- 1. Parking at all GMU facilities requires a permit or fee payment at meters or parking decks.
- 2. Motorcycle adhesive permits must be displayed in clear view on the motorcycle.
- 3. Permit is only valid in motorcycle parking areas. Motorcycles cannot park in a regular parking space in any lot or parking deck.
- 4. Motorcycles are required to park in designated motorcycle parking areas outside of the Aquatic Center, Thompson Hall/Finley Building, Parking Services Building, and in Lots C, J, and the 1st level of the Rappahannock River Parking Deck.
- 5. Permit is also valid in the motorcycle designated areas of the King & Discovery Lot at Science and Technology.
- 6. Mopeds, scooters, and bicycles are categorized as motorcycles for permits, where applicable.
- 7. Only one motorcycle can park per space.
- 8. Permit holder is always responsible for their vehicle and must pay attention to any special signs regarding lot closures and other temporary restrictions or changes to parking regulations.
- 9. Permit is for use by authorized owner only and cannot be transferred to other people.
- 10. Permit is not allowed to be resold, duplicated, or altered in any manner.
- 11. Permit does not guarantee a space in any specific area.
