Ralph Buehler, PhD is Professor and Chair in Urban Affairs and Planning at Virginia Tech's Research Center in Arlington. He is an internationally known expert on bicycling and walking and author of 40 refereed articles on walking and cycling in academic journals. Recently, MIT Press published Buehler's second edited book "[Cycling for Sustainable Cities](#)" in which authors from 5 continents explore how to make city cycling—the most sustainable means of travel—safe, practical, and convenient for all. Dr. Buehler's work has been cited widely. Universities, governments, and NGOs in the U.S. and abroad have invited him to present this research. Between 2012 and 2018, he served as chair of the Committee for Bicycle Transportation of the Transportation Research Board (TRB) of the National Academies.
