SCOOTERS

Mason is participating in a scooter pilot in conjunction with the City of Fairfax through 12/31/2022. Scooters must stay in the eligible area. Please see transportation.gmu.edu/shared-mobility for important information including scooter corral locations, a definition of the eligible area, and no-ride/no-park zones.

METRO RAIL

1. **Stay up-to-date with METRO. Sign up for alerts at www.wmata.com/rider-guide/**
2. **Masks are optional; allow extra time to get to your destination.**

The closest Metro stop in Fairfax is the Vienna Metro station on the Orange Line. The Orange Line also goes to various locations in Washington, DC and connects to the Silver Line that serves Reston, Tysons Corner, and East Falls Church. To visit Mason Square (formerly the Arlington campus), take the Orange Line to Virginia Square-GMU.

PARKING – Some Tips to Help Get You Started

Permits

- Parking permits are required to park in any lot on Mason property.
- Most Fairfax permits can be used at SciTech but not at Mason Square (formerly Arlington). If you have classes at Mason Square you can obtain a Mason Square permit which can also be used in Fairfax and SciTech general permit areas.

Where to Park

- Parking lots can fill up fast. Allow extra time, especially the first few weeks of class to find a space.
- On the busiest of days, it is recommended that those arriving to campus later in the morning park in Lot K, Lot L or at the Field House, a 15-minute walk to the Johnson Center, as the lots on east campus will often fill. Also, don't forget that general lot permits are valid on Levels 1-2 of Rappahannock River Parking Deck (but not in the visitor area).
- A reminder that parking permits are required to park in any lot on Mason property.

Citations and Enforcement

- Always read the signs to know if a lot or area is restricted to a certain type of permit. Do not park in reserved, service/repair, state vehicle, administrative spaces, or any other specifically marked space.
- Parking lots are enforced all year round, including the first week of classes and even when classes are not in session. Don't believe the myths and rumors about a grace period.
- Check the parking website parking.gmu.edu for the latest information regarding hours of enforcement and other important news affecting parking on campus, even when classes are not in session.

Visitor Parking

- Visitor parking is available in Mason Pond, Shenandoah, and Rappahannock River Parking Decks for \$5/hour with a \$18 daily maximum. At the Field House and in Lots M& P, a daily permit for \$7 can be purchased online or using ParkMobile. SHUTTLE ROUTES FALL 2022

Visit shuttle.gmu.edu for updated shuttle schedules and to learn more about transportation options which save you money and help lower CO2 emissions. A Mason ID is required to ride Mason Shuttles.

Download the Reston Limousine Service (RLS) app or visit mason.ridesystems.net to track your shuttle. Schedules are available at shuttle.gmu.edu. Shuttle schedules below are subject to change.

Shuttle Guidance

1. Check shuttle times for all routes as there have been service changes.
2. Burke VRE is no longer operating.
3. Masks are optional on board all Mason Shuttles.
4. Allow extra time to get to your destination.
5. No visitors on Mason Shuttles until further notice.

Fixed Route: Fairfax/Mason Square (formerly Arlington)

The Fairfax/Mason Square shuttle operates Monday-Friday between the Fairfax and Mason Square campuses. Stops at Rappahannock River Lane on the Fairfax Campus and at Fairfax Circle (Lee Highway & Circle Woods Drive) both inbound and outbound.

No weekend service.

Fixed Route: Fairfax/SciTech Campus Shuttle - FREE PARKING AT MANASSAS MALL (designated area only)

The Fairfax/SciTech Campus shuttle operates Monday-Friday between the Fairfax and SciTech campuses. Shuttle also stops at Manassas Mall between campuses.

Limited weekend service

Fixed Route: Gunston Mason

The Gunston Mason route provides service from the Fairfax Campus to area shopping centers and Ridge Top Road, Monday-Friday. Stops at Sandy Creek, RAC, Rappahannock River Lane, and Masonvale (on-campus) and Fair Lakes Center, Whole Foods (Market Commons Dr), Fair Lakes Promenade, Fair Oaks Mall, Fairfax Corner, and Ridge Top Road off-campus.

Limited weekend service.

Fixed Route: Sandy Creek/Metro Shuttle

The shuttle operates between Sandy Creek Transit Center and Vienna Metro with stops at Masonvale and Rappahannock River Lane (on-campus) and the Student Townhouses, Commerce Building, Fairfax Circle (at Lee Highway & Circle Woods Drive), and the Vienna Metro, North side, Bay C (off-campus).

No weekend service – See CUE Bus and On-Demand Shuttle

West Campus Shuttle

The shuttle route operates between West Campus, Rapidan River Rd, Field House, the RAC, Cabrera Global Center, Mason Pond Dr/Patriot Circle (EagleBank Arena side), Presidents Park, Masonvale (Patriot Circle & Staffordshire), Rappahannock River Lane, and returns by the RAC, Cabrera Global Center, Field House, Rapidan River Lane, to West Campus. Does not operate in summer.

No weekend service – See On-Demand Shuttle

On-Demand Shuttle – Weekends Only

The On-Demand shuttle is a shared ride service between established stops on and around the Fairfax Campus. It does not serve the SciTech or Mason Square Campuses. Stops may vary based on the day or time. Download the TransLoc app to access the shuttle and view stops or visit shuttle.gmu.edu for details. You cannot pre-book a ride and the wait time for the shuttle is based upon how many requests are pending.
